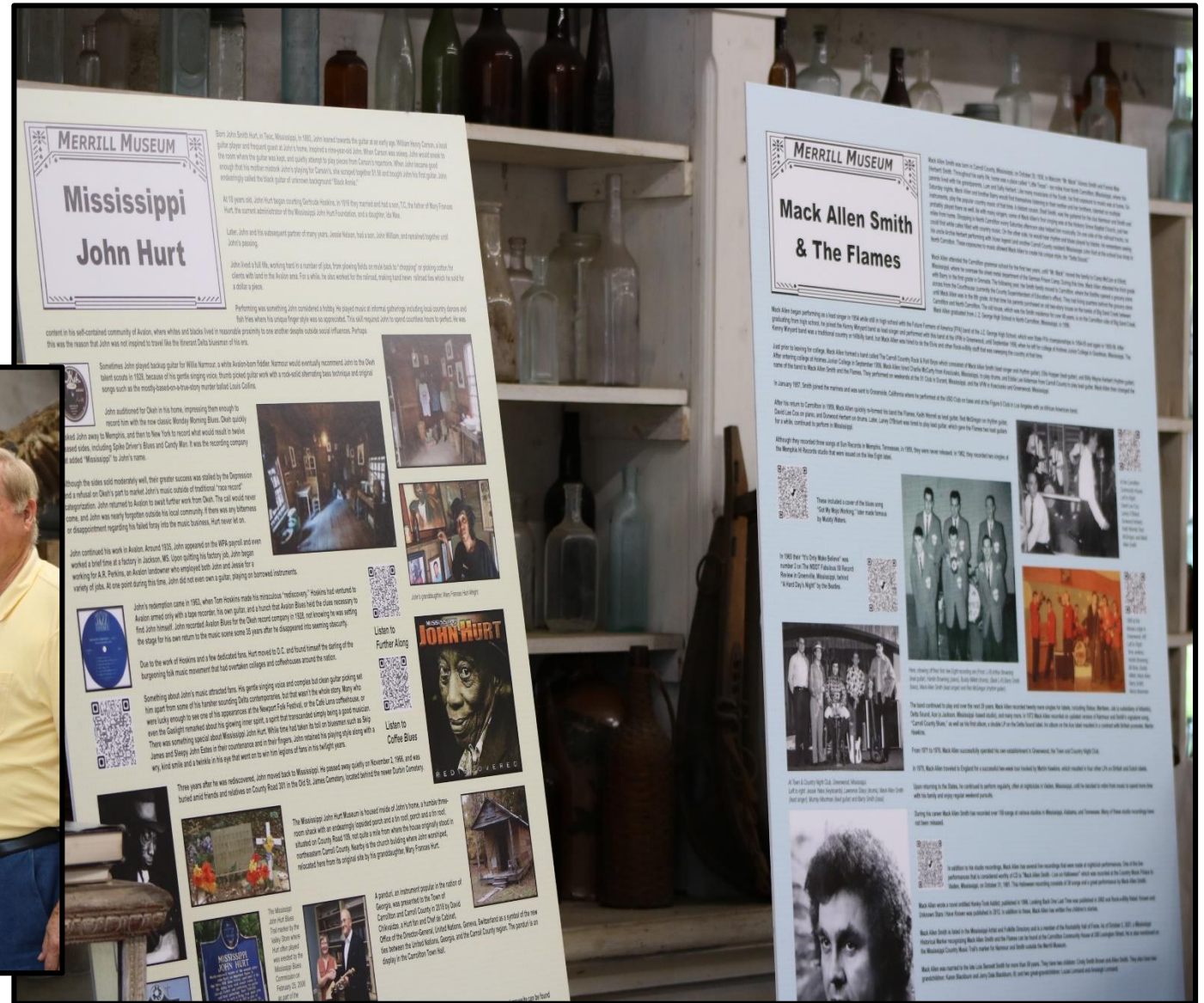








We added a new music exhibit in the Merrill Museum.

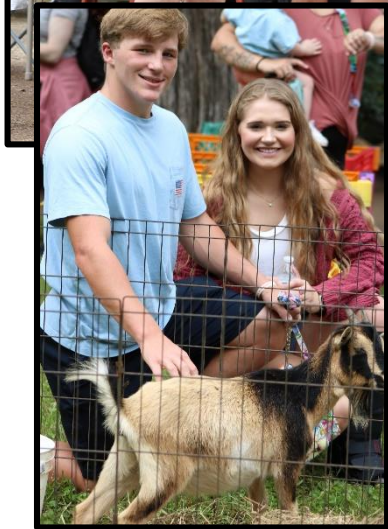
# Learning History through Mississippi Markers

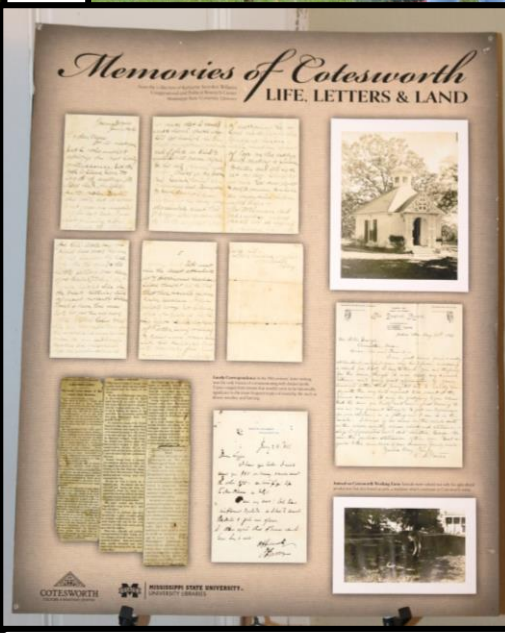
